

Exhibition Guidelines:

For public & private school teachers and home-school educators teaching K-8th grade in Benton, Washington, Madison, and Carroll counties. Home-schooled students must be entered by their parents or guardians.

Dates: March 5th - 29th, 2010

Drop off: Thurs & Fri, Feb 25th- 26th, 2010

Pick up: Mon - Wed, Mar 30th- Apr 1st

*No work may be picked up before April 4th

*All work should be picked up by the teacher, parent or appointed representative no later than April 8th (*unclaimed work will become property of the ACO*)

Open House: Sat Mar 6th, 2009; 1-3 pm

Teachers are responsible for informing students and parents of the open house.

Restrictions: Each student may submit up to two entries. Each school may submit up to 6 entries per grade.

Presentation: Two-dimensional works must be matted and properly prepared for hanging.



The plastic hang tab found at Hobby Lobby is the required hangtab.(see example)

The Springdale Hobby Lobby will have an adequate supply of hangtabs.

The saw tooth part of the hang tab should protrude *slightly* from the top of the work for easy hanging.

Three-dimensional work should be free standing or display pedestal ready.

Teachers must make labels to be displayed on the front of the work.

Labels must be made using a self adhesive label.

Labels must be visible and securely attached to the work.

Three-dimensional work must be physically labeled and must also have a table top label to display with the work.

Labeling: labels must include the following information

<p>Student's Name</p> <p>Teacher's Name</p> <p>School Name (if homeschooled just write "Homeschool")</p> <p>Grade Level</p> <p>Title of work (if work does not have a title, write "untitled")</p>
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Work not properly labeled or prepared for hanging or display will not be included in the show.

List of works: Include a List of Works Form with each school's entries. Please Print Legibly.

Liability: Care will be taken in handling the artwork; however, the Arts Center of the Ozarks cannot be responsible for loss or damage.
